Insurance: Heath Evangelical Church is insured for Public Liability. This insurance provides protection for campers should they have an accident which was due to the negligence of the leaders or organisers of Heath Evangelical Church Camps. Would you please note, however, that the above insurance does not include personal accident cover for campers. If, therefore, a camper receives an injury for which Heath Evangelical Church, its leaders or camp organisers are not liable there will be no entitlement to payment from Heath Evangelical Church's insurers. Parents/individuals should consider taking out their own Personal Accident Insurance should they decide that such cover is necessary.

Health & Safety: Heath Evangelical Church complies with prepared Health & Safety and Child Protection policies. All leaders and other staff will hold a current DBS certificate and transport will only be provided in vehicles that are appropriate, insured and roadworthy. Each camp will have a qualified first aider/medical officer.

Data Protection Information

The current GDPR (2018) legislation provides you as a camper or parent/guardian with the right to know what we will do with the personal data you have provided about yourself and/or your child, why we collect it and what we do with it.

Our lawful bases for collecting and processing personal data about you and your child are Legitimate Interest and Consent.

We use the personal data for the following purposes:

- 1. To ensure that we can contact you or your specified alternative contact about your child e.g. in the event of an accident, sickness or injury.
- 2. To ensure that your child does not take part in any activities that you have not agreed to.
- 3. To ensure that we are able to properly consider the needs of your child during activities they may participate in whilst on camp.
- 4. To inform you about future camps and other Heath Evangelical Church activities etc.

Your rights

The legislation provides you with certain rights, including to request a copy of your personal data or that we update/delete the personal data we hold. You have a right to withdraw your consent to Heath Evangelical Church processing your personal data at any time. However, in this event you/your child may not be able to attend camp.

How long will we keep your personal data?

Heath Evangelical Church will keep you/your child's information for the duration of camp and for three years thereafter.
